# DISCERNING EVIL & DECEPTION 1 JN 2:18-27

Part 2

## I. (Review) CHARACTERISTICS OF THE DECEIVERS

- A. 19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us. But they went out, that it might become plain that they all are not of us.
- B. They went out from us-> "us" is the church,-> they will eventually leave
  - 1. **Deceivers are in the church!** They looked like faithful men/women of God at one point!
  - 2. But, "they were not of us" -> these were NOT true believers, false converts
  - 3. for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us.
    - a. John emphasizes here that true believers remained through all the turmoil caused

#### C. Perseverance is the ultimate test of True Saint

- 1. for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us.
- 2. But they went out, that it might become plain that they all are not of us.
- 3. Their leaving demonstrated exactly who they were–imposters

## II. BELIEVERS HAVE BEEN GIVEN THE TRUTH!

- A. 20 ¶ But you have been anointed by the Holy One, and you all have knowledge.
- B. you -> are the true believers who walk steadfast in the faith of the gospel
  - 1. No man can sell himself the faith to believe in Jesus Christ
  - 2. John explains that true believers are anointed
- C. Heidelberg Confesion Q32. "Why are you called Christian?"
  - 1. "Because by faith I am a member of Christ and so share His anointing. I am anointed to confess His name, to present myself to Himas a living sacrifice of thanks, to strive with a free conscience against sin and the devil in this life, and afterwards to reign with Christ over all creation for all eternity."
- D. Anyone can know information and facts about God and salvation but only when one is anointed do they actually put faith in that information.
  - 1. This is not some ceremony of oil or baptism by holy water
  - 2. 2c<sub>0</sub> 1:21 And **it is God** who establishes us with you **in Christ**, and has anointed us, 22 and who has also put his seal on us and given us his **Spirit** in our hearts as a guarantee.
  - 3. God anoints through Christ and by the Holy Spirit
  - 4. Jesus is the Holy One -> Lu 4:34. . .Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!"
  - 5. Anointing is the coming of the Holy Spirit into the heart of a believer to reveal truth to their hearts.

## E. TRUE BELIEVERS are guided the Holy Spirit- they all have knowledge.

- 1. Lit. "You have an anointing from the Holy One and you know all."
  - a. Does not mean that believers know all there is to know about go
  - b. Rather "all" pertains to the truth of the gospel
    - (1) God is holy, man is completely sinful
    - (2) Jesus Christ is the only hope for salvation.
    - (3) Christ is both God and man
    - (4) lived a perfect life, therefore was the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all that would believe
    - (5) that in a way we do not understand, our sin is put on Him and His death becomes payment for our sins
    - (6) and His righteousness is put on our account
    - (7) therefore we as believers stand positionally perfect before God.
- 2. They may have heard it before, but Spirit actually makes it "the truth" in the person's heart—> this truth becomes Saving Faith
- F. v21 "I do not write because you do not know truth, but because you know truth!"
  - 1. John 14:26 "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.
  - 2. Joh 16:13 "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

#### III. TRUE BELIEVERS KNOW AND HOLD ONTO THE TRUTH!

- A. 21 I write to you, not because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and because no lie is of the truth.
- B. True believers, because of the Spirit living in them, know when they hear a lie
- C. These that left were NOT children of God—> they have NOT been born from above!
  - 1. 19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us. But they went out, that it might become plain that they all are not of us.
- D. As John already has said, Believers know the truth and they know what lies sound like
- E. John reminding them of who they are and what they already know—don't be lured into confusion by false teachers
- F. "no lie is of the truth" stick to what you have been taught by the Holy Spirit
- G. Then and now, believers must stand on truth that God has reveals to them
  - 1. From the beginning in Eden the attack of Satan was against God's truth
- H. You know who Jesus Christ is and what Work He has done—> you must stand on truth
- I. True believers know truth and are able to discern truth from error or lies

#### IV. WHAT IS THE TRUTH?

- A. 22 Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the Son.
- B. How do you know if a person is a false teacher?
  - 1. Straight forward test of truth—> anyone who questions or denies that Jesus is actually the Messiah, the Christ is a liar!
  - 2. Not talking about one that occasionally misrepresents the truth
  - 3. To deny and truth about Christ is to Deny of the entire gospel!
  - 4. Christian faith is based on the fact that Jesus was both man and God!
    - a. And that Christ is the only way to Eternal Life
- C. Gnostic heretics denied everything about Jesus– they are liars.
- D. This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the Son—> these are sons of Satan
  - 1. Not addressing the one antichrist that comes at the end of time, but anyone who claims that Jesus in NOT the Christ.
  - 2. All that deny the deity of Jesus Christ are in this category!
  - 3. Without the Son, there is no Father.
  - 4. John 1:2 **He** was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.
- E. 23 No one who denies the Son has the Father.
  - 1. God the Father sent God the Son to redeem sinners
  - 2. One who rejects Christ, rejects the Father and rejects the gospel
  - 3. no such thing as having a relationship with God the Father and deny His son.
  - 4. Any religion that rejects the absolute deity of Jesus Christ is a false religion.
  - 5. Any teacher that preaches anything that contradicts salvation through Christ alone by faith alone—> is a false teacher, a LIAR!
- F. 23b...Whoever confesses the Son has the Father also.
  - 1. Every believer's confession must be, "Jesus is the Son of God"
  - 2. Purified by the blood of the Son-1 John 1:7 .. . the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
  - 3. Eternal Life promised by the Son-> 1 John 2:25 And this is the promise that he made to us—eternal life.
  - 4. Atoning Sacrifice by the death of the Son -> 1John 4:10 In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
  - 5. Through the Son we have fellowship with the Father -> 1John 1:3 . . . indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ.
  - 6. Simple definition of Christianity -> those who profess Jesus Christ
  - 7. And they that profess Jesus Christ are in true fellowship with God the Father
